Teaching Assistant Positions (Fall and Winter)

Remuneration will be based upon the rated hours and the hourly rates stipulated below (based on January 1, 2022 and January 1, 2023 rate). The position(s) posted is (are) tentative, pending final course determinations and enrolments.

Rate of Pay

There is a union and bargaining unit in operation in the University. Effective January 1, 2022 the wage rate of pay for a UG, SGS I, SGS II and PDF is \$47.17 per hour, in accordance with the Collective Agreement between the Governing Council of the University of Toronto and the Canadian Union of Public Employees, Local 3902. Effective January 1, 2023 the wage rate will increase to \$47.64.
